April 8, May 13, June 10, July 8, Aug 12, Sept 9, Oct 14, Nov 11. No collection in December, and evergreen trees are collected in January only.

SPRING BURNING IN THE VILLAGE OF DANE



Burning leaves, garden waste, and small sticks can be done from April 1 to May 15 each year. Burning is to be done after 6:00 pm and before 6:00 am and **never on Sundays!** These rules are per village

ordinances. Before you burn check the weather and wind conditions. Please be extremely careful if you do have any type of fire and always stay attentive.

IT'S MULCH SEASON.... WHY YOU MULCH AROUND A TREE

Mulching insulates the soil, helping to provide a buffer from heat and cold, retains water to help roots stay moist, and reduces lawn mower or weed trimming damage to tree trunks.

THE PROPER WAY TO APPLY MULCH AROUND A TREE



Remove any grass within a 3-foot area. Place natural mulch such as wood chips or bark pieces 2 to 4 inches deep within circle. Keep the mulch from touching the trunk

of the tree.
